1. Application form would be filled by the candidate at the venue itself.
2. A payment of Rs. 10,000/- towards the registration fee (Non-refundable) can be **paid only through Demand Draft** drawn in favour of “**Chairman, Admissions, Gautam Buddha University**” payable at Delhi, Noida & Greater Noida from any nationalized bank. A candidate without required Registration Fee will not be allowed to take part in counseling process.
3. Hostel exemption would not ordinarily be allowed. Only in exceptional circumstances can it be allowed on case to case by the competent Authority.
4. A candidate shall be present physically for document verification and he/she is required to bring relevant documents in original, e.g., Certificates and Mark-sheets of X, XII, Graduation, Post graduation (as applicable), NATA Score (as applicable), Migration/Transfer Certificate, Caste Certificate for SC/ST or OBC or Domicile Certificate, Income Certificate, Aadhar Card and any other document for verification purposes along with a set of self attested photocopies of the above said documents.
